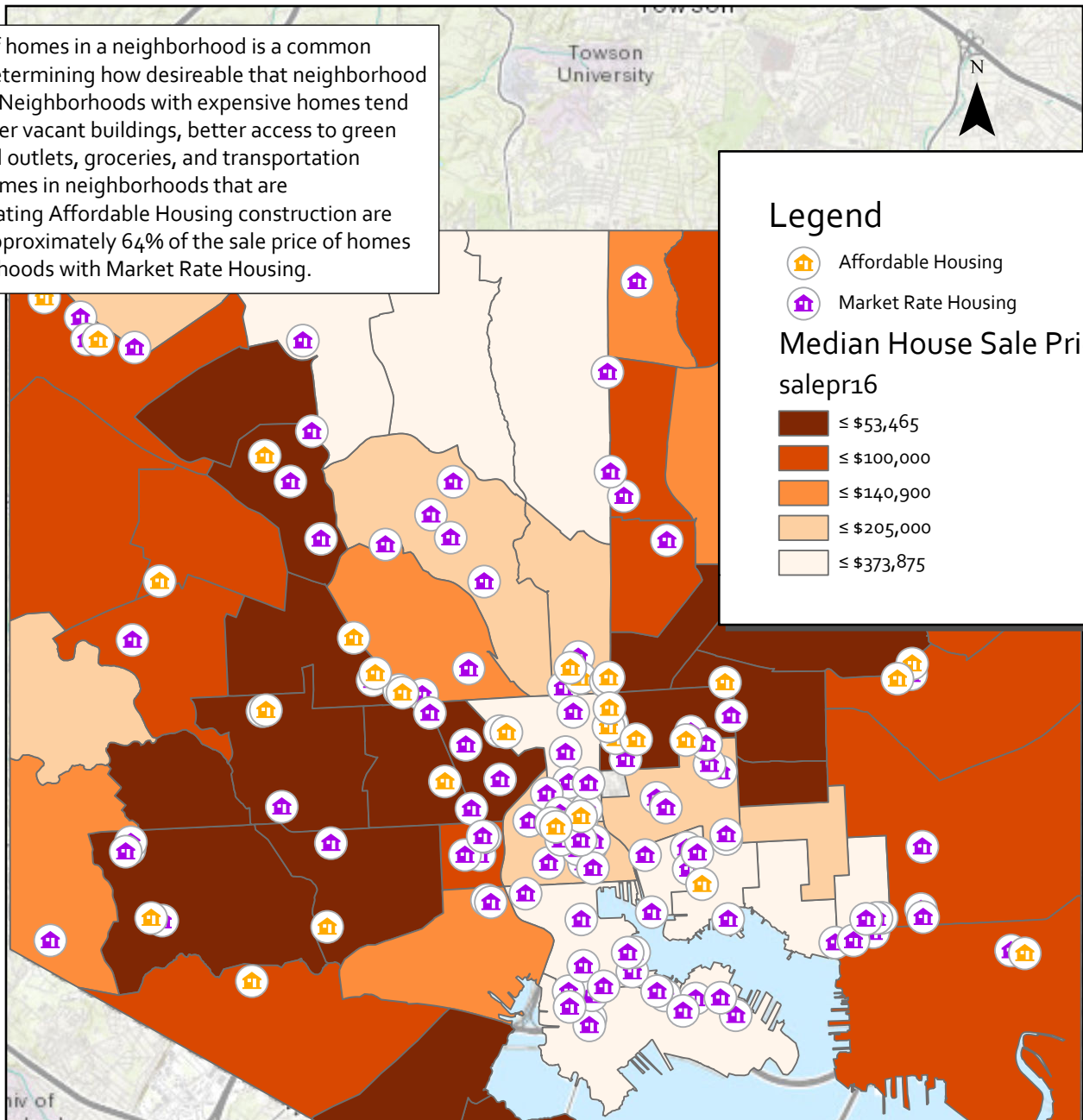


Baltimore City Affordable Housing Efficiency Assessment: Median House Sale Price

The price of homes in a neighborhood is a common proxy for determining how desirable that neighborhood is to live in. Neighborhoods with expensive homes tend to have fewer vacant buildings, better access to green space, retail outlets, groceries, and transportation options. Homes in neighborhoods that are accommodating Affordable Housing construction are going for approximately 64% of the sale price of homes in neighborhoods with Market Rate Housing.
