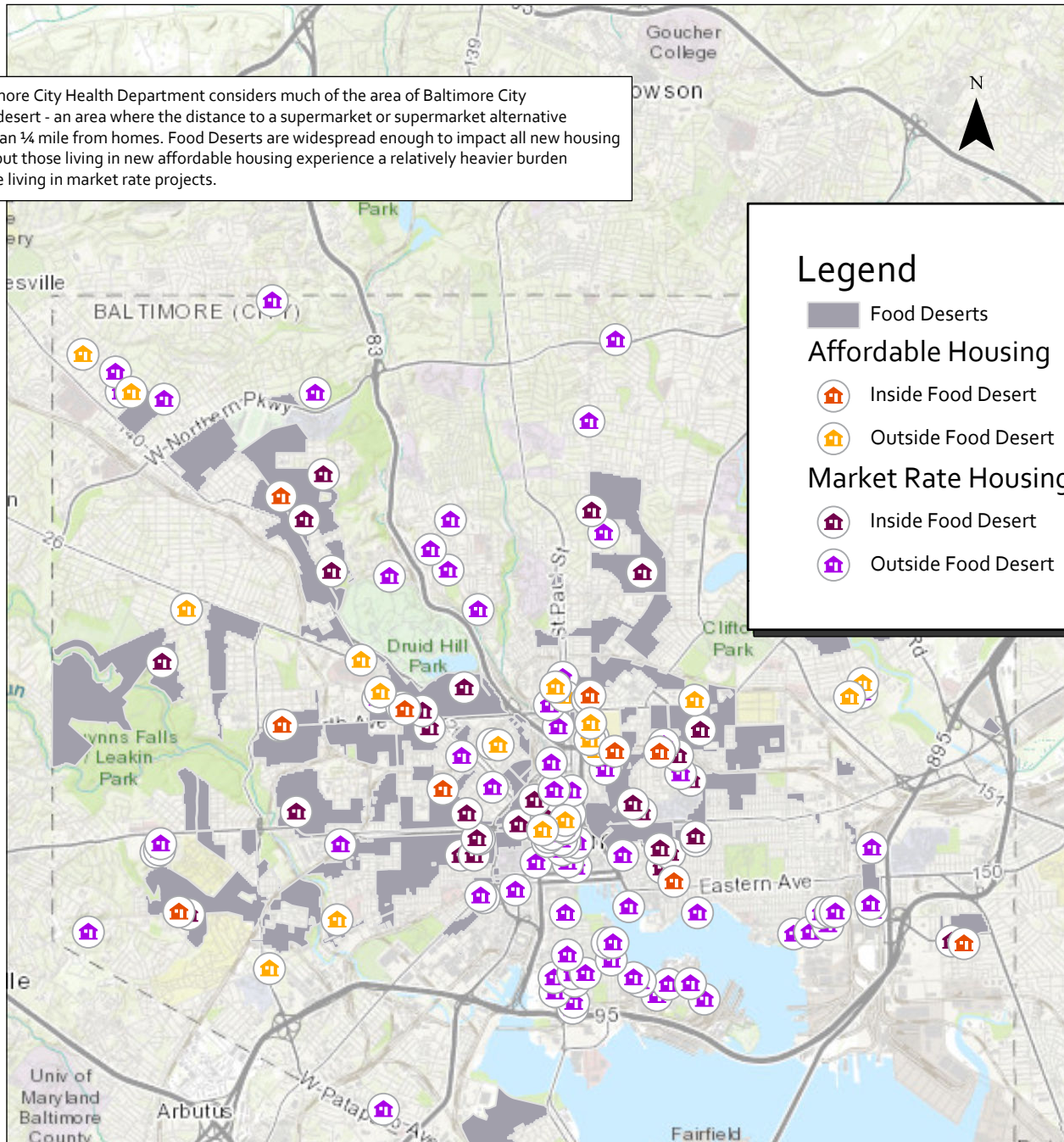


Baltimore City Affordable Housing Efficiency Assessment: Food Deserts

The Baltimore City Health Department considers much of the area of Baltimore City as a food desert - an area where the distance to a supermarket or supermarket alternative is more than ¼ mile from homes. Food Deserts are widespread enough to impact all new housing projects, but those living in new affordable housing experience a relatively heavier burden than those living in market rate projects.
